Booking

Arrival at Belfast International Airport

We provide a free transfer service to and from Belfast International Airport only (closest airport to the training facility). Transfers from Belfast City Airport are not available.

In order to avail of the free transfer service from Belfast International Airport all flights must be due to arrive on or before 8:15am. The free transfer service leaves the airport at 8.30am and you will be returned to Belfast International Airport for approximately 5:00pm. (30 minutes transfer time from facility to airport.)

Unfortunately we are unable to provide transfers from any other airport/station or at any other time.

Upon arrival at Belfast International Airport please turn on your mobile phone and immediately proceed to the “Meeting Point” (beside the bag carousel at Arrivals), where a K Rend representative (with a sign) will be waiting for you. This representative will then direct you to your free transfer to the training facility. The representatives mobile number will be provided to you the day before the course.

Note: If you miss the free transfer service that leaves the airport at 8.30am you then become responsible for making your own way to the facility (approx cost is £30 for a one-way taxi).

Staying in Larne (town training facility is based in)

If you choose to stay in Larne the night before the course commences we can provide free transfers from your accommodation on the day of the course to the training facility and a free transfer back to Belfast International Airport. Allow 30 minutes transfer time from facility to airport. Note that no transfers will be made to Belfast City Airport. You must make your own way from the airport to your accommodation in Larne the night before the course. Taxi costs approx £30.

Things to do in Larne

Larne is a small seaside town (population of 20,000) with a selection of pubs to enjoy. Larne is the gateway to the world famous Nine Glens of Antrim and the Antrim Coast Road, an area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, protected by the National Trust. With its beautiful countryside and striking coastal scenery it is not surprising that a number of Larne's best attractions can be found in the great outdoors including: Causeway Coastal Route, Carnfunnock Country Park, Glenarm Castle Walled Garden, The Glens of Antrim and Straidkilly Nature Reserve. Additionally there are shopping opportunities; leisure activities in Larne Leisure Centre and heritage attractions include Larne Historical Centre. Staying in Belfast
