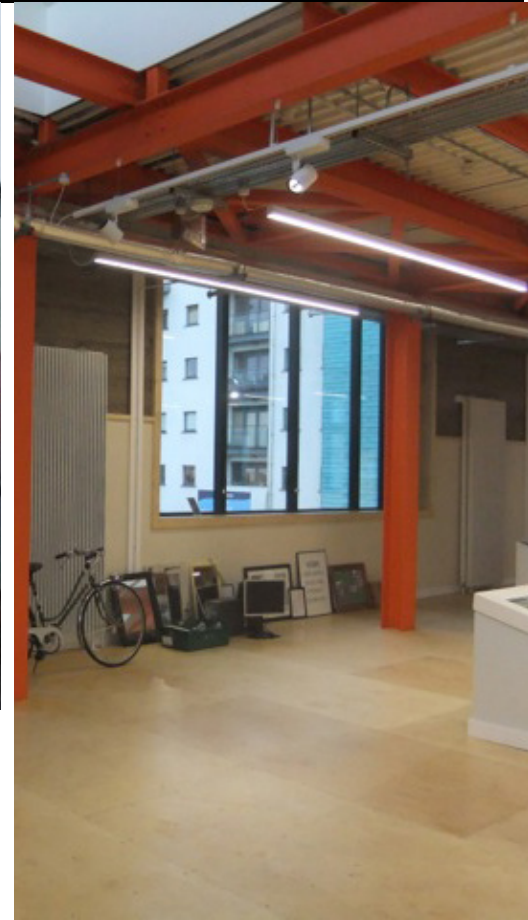


CASE STUDY:

Ballymun Boiler House, Dublin



Hemp Lime Binder chosen for Ballymun Boiler house

The Ballymun Boiler House was built in the 1960's to provide drinking water, hot water and heating to the 36 newly built flat blocks and some associated public buildings. It was the largest mass heating system in Ireland at the time of construction, and had an unusual aspect to its service in that it could pump fresh drinking water straight to the

flats from a nearby reservoir. It was a modern amenity at the time, and the new residents would have been some of the first living with such technology. The Boiler House site is located on the main street of Ballymun.

The building was earmarked for demolition but instead got a makeover with Hemp Lime Binder. Ballymun Boiler house, project is now completed with a big success.
